



## Roanoke/Cashie River Center

The Roanoke/Cashie River Center is situated on a six-acre tract along on the Cashie River in Windsor, NC. The Center houses exhibits that highlight the Roanoke and Cashie rivers, regional wildlife, and local history. In addition, the site has an amphitheater, a picnic area, canoe rentals, and a boardwalk/boat ramp along the river for public use.

### Features and Activities

- ▶ hands-on exhibits, with new displays focusing on neotropical songbirds
- ▶ diorama of local bottomland habitats
- ▶ an active beehive display
- ▶ artifacts from the region's past
- ▶ wetland ponds with interpretive signage
- ▶ regular programs on local ecology, history, and cultural heritage
- ▶ special programs for schools and other groups
- ▶ canoe rentals and beach for launching canoes and kayaks

### Fun Facts

- ▶ The lower Roanoke has the largest intact floodplain forests east of the Mississippi River valley.
- ▶ The Roanoke River is by far the longest and deepest river that empties into the Albemarle-Pamlico estuarine system.
- ▶ Over 400 miles long and 80 feet deep in some places, it delivers more water into the sounds than the rest of the tributary rivers combined.
- ▶ The Cashie is the longest river in the U.S. that begins and ends in the same county (Bertie).
