| ___4. Delta | D. Boat built of 2 logs and sometimes sails |
| ___5. Dam | E. Brackish water where river water meets ocean water |
| ___6. Watershed | F. Birds of prey |
| ___7. Raptors | G. Animal that feeds upon other animals |
| ___8. Anadromous Fish | H. Area of land drained by a river or other body of water |
| ___9. Pound Net | I. Canoe built by hollowing out long sections of trees |
| ___10. Kunner | J. Areas of undisturbed land along forest/crop lands to prevent sediment run-off |
| ___11. Estuary | K. Monofilament underwater net which traps fish by the gills |
| ___12. Brackish | L. Island formed by deposits of river sediment carried downstream |
